✗ Return to START.



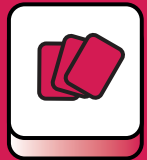
Your letter of invitation is in the letterbox!

	The year 2033: you vote electronically.  Move forward 3 squares.	<p>The count is completed after a second check. The polling assistants forward the results to the central election office.  Move forward to the FINISH LINE.</p>		You have already voted by post.  Move forward 3 squares.
	The polling assistants ask for your ID.  Sit out a round if you didn't bring it.	You count the ballot papers with other polling assistants. You do your job flawlessly.  Move forward 1 square.		
	A polling assistant ticks off all voters who show up.  Go back 5 squares.	You went to the wrong election office.  Go back 5 squares.		There's a queue at the election office! Use the time to look through the list of candidates one more time.  Sit out a round – unless you can name two candidates for the EU elections.
